The following draft rules which the Government proposes to make under Section 127 of the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001 (Goa Act 36 of 2001) (hereinafter referred to

as the “said Act”), are hereby pre-published as required by sub-section (3) of section 127 of the said Act, for information of the persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft rules will be taken into consideration by the Government on the expiry of 30 days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

All objections and suggestions to the said draft rules may be forwarded to the Registrar of Co-operative Societies and ex officio Joint Secretary to the Government of Goa, Co-operative Department, 4th & 5th Floor, ‘Sahakar Sankul’, Patto, Panaji, Goa, before the expiry of the 30 days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette so that they may be taken into consideration at the time of finalization of the said draft rules.

DRAFT RULES

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) & (2) of section 127 read with sub-section (6A) of Section 59 of the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001 (Goa Act 36 of 2001) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to further amend the Goa Co-operative Societies Rules, 2003, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Co-operative Societies (Second Amendment) Rules, 2010.

(2) They shall come into force on such date as the Government may by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

2. *Insertion of new rule 111A.*— After rule 111 of the Goa Co-operative Societies Rules, 2003 (hereinafter referred to as the “Principal Rules”), the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“111A. *Bond to be executed by members of committee, set up by the Board of Directors or the Directors of a society, as the case may be.*— Every member of the committee set up by the Board of Directors and the Directors of the society, shall execute a bond in Form “LL” hereto within fifteen days of his assuming the office. Such bond shall be executed on the stamp paper as provided under the Indians Stamp Act, 1899 (2 of 1899). The

expenditure on stamp paper shall be borne by the society. The Chief Executive Officer/Secretary of the Society shall receive such bonds and keep them on record of the society and accordingly inform the Registrar within fifteen days from formation of the Committee.”

3. *Insertion of new Form “LL”.*— In the principal Rules, after Form “ELECTION-17”, the following form shall be inserted, namely:—

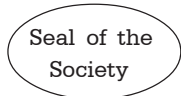

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 35 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Fire Force Act, 1986 (Act No. 9 of 1986), the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to amend the Goa State Fire Force Rules, 1997, as follows, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa State Fire Force (Amendment) Rules, 2009.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of Appendix VII.*— For Appendix VII appended to the Goa State Fire Force Rules, 1997, the following Appendix shall be substituted, namely:—

A Scheme for undertaking any work in the Panchayat areas of common nature affecting two or more Village Panchayats through an External Agency

The Government of Goa is hereby pleased to frame a Scheme for undertaking any work in the Panchayat areas of which is common nature and affecting two or more Village Panchayats through an external Agency as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) This Scheme may be called the Goa Outsourcing of Works in Panchayat Areas Scheme, 2010.

(2) It shall come into force at once w.e.f. its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Purposes.*— (1) The Government shall sanction the necessary grants to the Directorate of Panchayats for incurring the expenditure for outsourcing any work in the Panchayat areas which is of common nature and affecting two or more Village Panchayats, through an external Agency.

(2) The Government may outsource such work of the Village Panchayats through an external Agency which the Village Panchayat is required to provide under the Goa Panchayat Raj Act, 1994 and rules made thereunder after consultation with the respective Panchayats and if the Government is satisfied that the Village Panchayat is unable to provide such public service due to lack of capacity, either technically or financially.

3. *Only works of common nature to be outsourced.*— The Government may

outsource only such kinds of public works in the Village Panchayat areas which commonly affects two or more Village Panchayats.

4. *Outsourcing of work through External Agency.*— The Government may execute the work through any Government Department or through any private Agency or any Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) having the necessary expertise for execution of such work.

5. The required funds for executing the works under this Scheme shall be sanctioned by the Government to the Directorate of Panchayats under the following Budget Head:

2215 — Other Rural Development Programme.

00 —

101 — Panchayati Raj.

20 — Rural Garbage Disposal & Stray Cattle Menace.

50 — Other Charges.

6. For the purpose of executing the works under this Scheme, through an external Agency, the Director of Panchayats shall enter into an Agreement/Memorandum of Understanding with the Government Department/External Agency/Non Government Organization stipulating therein, the terms and conditions for execution of the work and payment therefor after following the required codal formalities.

7. *Miscellaneous.*— Government may modify, alter, add or cancel any condition of the Scheme from time to time.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Goa General Service, Group 'B', Non-Ministerial, Gazetted post, in the Directorate of Women and Child Development, Government of Goa, namely:—

1. *Short title, application and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Directorate of Women and Child Development, Group 'B', Non-Ministerial, Gazetted post, Recruitment Rules, 2010.

(2) They shall apply to the post specified in column (1) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").

(3) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number, classification and scale of pay.*— The number of posts, classification of the said post and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule:

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts specified in column (2) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as

specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Goa Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.

These rules are issued in consultation with the Goa Public Service Commission conveyed vide their letter No. COM/II/13/66(1)/2010/783 dated 3-5-2010.

Whereas certain draft Amendment Rules which the Government of Goa proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) read with clause (f) of sub-section (2) of section 24 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1974 (8 of 1974) and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, were published as required by sub-section (1) of section 24 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1974 (Act No. 8 of 1974) in the Official Gazette No. 5 Series I dated 29-4-2010 under Notification No. 5/1/2009-TPT/50 dated 16-4-2010 of the Department of Transport, Panaji-Goa, inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby within 15 days from the date of publication in the Official Gazette;

And whereas, the said Gazette was made available to the public on 29-4-2010;

And whereas, no objections and suggestions have been received from the public on the said draft Amendment Rules by the Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) read with clause (f) of sub-section (2) of section 24 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1974 (8 of 1974) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to amend the Goa, Daman and Diu Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1974, as follows, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Motor Vehicles Tax (Amendment) Rules, 2010.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of rule 22.*— In rule 22 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Motor Vehicles Tax Rules, 1974, in sub-rule (1) after clause (xiii), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(xiv) A trailer attached to any motor vehicle which is used solely for the agricultural operation and for the activities related to agriculture but not for the transportation of persons..... Whole.”
